1: Robert Broner "Reclining Nude" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas board painting depicting an abstract reclining female nude figure in a color field. Robert Broner (American, b. 1922) studied with S.W. Hayter at the experimental print workshop Atelier 17. He used the traditional techniques of engraving, etching, aquatint, lithography and phot-lithography, silkscreen and woodcut, and it credited with the development of several new techniques, including texture imprint. Broner is known for using found objects in his printmaking.



2: Carl Saxild "Geometric Forms" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas painting depicting intersecting geometric forms in various colors from orange, brown and green. The artwork is housed in a simple, brown wood frame.Carl Saxild (1893-1971) was an American painter who worked in the styles of Realism and Impressionism. Saxild exhibited at the Exhibition of Contemporary American Art at the World's Fair at New York's Flushing Meadows. He was a member of the Boston Arts Club and was represented by the Addison Gallery at the Phillips Academy, Andover, MA.



3: Max Kahn "Mining Country" Geometric Industrial Color Print

One color print depicting an abstract town with three coal cars sitting on a brown mountain. The cityscape has been rendered using black outlines around white buildings. The sky is yellow with a red sun and green hills line the horizon. The artwork is unhoused. Max Kahn (1902-2005) was a Litvik painter, lithographer, and sculptor who studied at Bradley University, and then with Charles Despiau, Antoine Bourdelle, and Othon Friesz at the Academy Suede West. He is known for his use of simple depictions and large forms.



4: Adolf Henry Aldrich "Spectators" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas painting of a man dressed in a dark suit standing in an urban, but deserted, area on a wide, yellow street. Buildings frame the street on either side with brick walls and uniform-colored planes of orange and yellow. A black lamppost sits on the right side of the street. A sector of ocean and a small grassy island can be seen in the background. Some figures appear to be walking along the water. The painting is housed in a decorative white wood frame.Adolf Henry Aldrich (1916-2010) was an American painter, sculptor, illustrator, architect, and set designer. He studied at the Art Students League in New York. Aldrich worked for the Federal Art Project under the WPA and created a woodcut entitled Shoeing Circus Horses. Aldrich worked at Atelier 17 in New York between 1947 and 1949.



5: Renato Natali Oil Painting of Three Figures Over a Fire in Silouette

One oil on plywood painting depicting three figures huddled over a fire at night, their backs facing the viewer and backlit by the fire's light. They stand in an urban area beside a building with a large window obstructing the left portion of the dark blue sky. Two of the figures are holding brooms, and a third broom leans against the building. A car and another building are depicted in the shadows of the right side of the background. Renato Natali (1883 – 1979) was an Italian painter, member of the post-Macchiaioli group of painters in Livorno during the first half of the 20th century. He often painted proletarian neighborhoods of the industrial port city of Livorno, as well as genre and cabaret scenes. Natali did not attend a formal academy, but studied under Guglielmo Micheli. He was a member of the Gruppo Labronico of painters that met in the CaffÃ[™] Bardi in Livorno.



6: Lorenzo Viani Oil Painting of a Crowded Market Scene

One oil painting on canvas of people in a crowded market scene. Several figures in the foreground wear dark skirts and colorful head coverings. The faces of the crowd lack detail, conveying a sense of motion. Cloth coverings over the marketsâ€[™] stands cast shadows around the crowd. The sunlight shines brightly on several buildings in the background, and a small patch of blue sky is depicted between the buildings. Lorenzo Viani (1882-1936) was an Italian painter, engraver, and poet. The Galleria d'Arte Moderna e Contemporanea, a museum of art in Viareggio, Italy, is known as "Lorenzo Viani? and holds 85 of his works.

One charcoal drawing of a somber and pensive man. The figure's face is drawn in angular style, elongated and dramatized with heavy shading. In the top left corner of the drawing there is Italian writing, including the artists signature and date, 1931. Lorenzo Viani (1882-1936) was an Italian painter, engraver, and poet. The Galleria d'Arte Moderna e Contemporanea, a museum of art in Viareggio, Italy, is known as "Lorenzo Viani? and holds 85 of his works.



8: Howard Ashman Patterson "Man Sleeping on a Park Bench" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas painting depicting a man sitting on a bench with his head titled back, potentially sleeping. He wears a suit and hat, and a vibrant red handkerchief is pouring out of his pants pocket and onto the bench. His face is loosely painted in a blue-green hue with pink highlights. The bench sits on a grey sidewalk in front of bright green patchy grass. A tree trunk is depicted in the top right corner. Howard Patterson (1891-1970) was an American painter and lithographer. He studied at the Pennsylvania Academy with Henry McCarter, the Philadelphia Museum School of Industrial Art, and the Art Students League in New York. He exhibited widely including at the National Academy of Design, the Nebraska Art Association in Lincoln, and Chappel House in Denver, Colorado. Throughout his life, Patterson would split his time between Europe and the United States, working and exhibiting across the United States and in Paris before passing away the age of 79 in Ossining, New York.



9: Marcia Hecht, "Mother and Her Two Children", Oil Painting

One oil on masonite painting depicting an abstract mother with her two children, one of whom is an infant. The artwork is housed in a closed-corner, decorative, gold- and green-colored wood frame with a silk-wrapped liner.



10: Alejandro Romero "Exploration I" Acrylic Painting

14: Paul Collomb Oil Painting of a Seated Woman in a Straw Hat

One oil painting on canvas painting depicting a seated woman wearing a sunhat, a blue green collared dress and a white apron. Houses are depicted in the background, and a black cat sits at the woman's side. The artwork is housed in a simple wood frame.Paul Collomb (1921 – 2010) was a French painter and lithographer. A native of Ain, he studied art in Paris before World War II. He won the Premier Second Grand Prix de Rome in 1950. Collomb's work has drawn comparisons to that of Maurice Boitel. His work can be found in the Mus©e d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris, the Centraal Museum in Utrecht, the Museum of Jakarta, the Museum of Tel Aviv, and the Museum of Modern Art in New York City.



15: Ray Richardson "Stitched Up" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas painting depicting a man in a red and white striped shirt and cowboy hat, his eyes directly engaging the viewer. In the background, to the left of the figure, a city street with one building and several vehicles in motion is depicted. A tall lampost divides the composition in half, stretching through a bright blue sky.Ray Richardson (b. 1964) studied at Central Saint Martins and Goldsmiths, University of London. He is known for cinematic paintings featuring working-class Londoners. Richardsonâ€[™]s painting Ostenders (ca. 1993â^e"94) sold for \$56,134 at auction in 2007. His honors include a BP Portrait Award Commendation (1990) and British Council Awards (1989, 1999, 2002). Richardsonâ€[™]s work can be found in the British Museum, the Victoria and Albert Museum, and Londonâ€[™]s National Portrait Gallery.



16: Thomas Billings "Empire Builder" Acrylic Painting

He began his career in Germany prior to World War II but achieved prominence as a staff photographer for Life magazine after moving to the U.S. Life featured more than 90 of his pictures on its covers, and more than 2,500 of his photo stories were published. Among his most famous cover photographs was V-J Day in Times Square, taken during the V-J Day celebration in New York City, showing an American sailor kissing a nurse.

Called "the queen of the bohemian artists", Abercrombie was involved in the Chicago jazz scene and was friends with musicians such as Dizzy Gillespie, Charlie Parker, and Sarah Vaughan, whose music inspired her own creative work.

The house is placed in the top right of the composition. The artwork is unhoused.Eugenie "Johnny? Gershoy (1901-1986) came to the United States from Russia when she was two years old. She grew up in New York and received her only formal art training through a scholarship at the Art Students League. During the 1920s, she moved to Woodstock, New York, and joined a lively colony of artists and writers. She carved sculptures from found materials, including applewood, fieldstone, and old gravestones, and also modeled portraits of other artists in the colony. Returning to New York City in the late 1930s, Gershoy completed several projects for the Works Progress Administration. These included a series of brightly colored circus figures for a children's library, and a group of large cement animals for a playground.



28: Charles Abel Corwin Oil Painting of "Boat Docks"

One oil on canvas painting depicting a coastal scene with the main focus on a tattered boat draped with a red tarp. The background shows a family sitting on a dock watching the boats in the harbor. The artwork is housed in a simple golden, wooden frame.Charles Abel Corwin (1857-1938) received his initial artistic training at the Cooper Union in New York, and the Royal Academy in Munich. In 1883, Corwin began teaching at the Art Institute of Chicago in 1883. In the 1890s, in addition to undertaking large-scale painting projects, he emerged as one of Chicagoãe™s rising painters of landscapes in oils and watercolors. He exhibited in the Art Institute's various annual exhibitions, beginning in 1894. Corwin painted along Lake Michigan, and in picturesque Gloucester, Massachusetts, a well-established artists' haunt.



29: In the Style of Salomon van Ruysdael, 19th Century Oil Painting of a Nautical Scene

One oil on canvas painting depicting three ships within a coastal landscape. The piece is painted in the style of Dutch Golden Age painter Salomon van Ruysdael. The large ship in the foreground displays the Dutch flag. The two ships in the background are positioned near each other, with their reflections on the water's surface. The artwork is housed in a black and gold-colored, decorative, wood frame.



30: Oil Painting by Milne Ramsey of a Nautical Scene at Sun Up "Fishing Boats"

One oil on wood painting depicting a nautical scene with a sailboat coming ashore set against a gray sky, painted with impressionist technique. The painting is housed in a decorative gilt wood frame with a linen liner.Milne Ramsey (1847 -1915) born in Philadelphia, entered the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts in 1863 and exhibited there from 1865 to 1867. He studied with Léon Bonnat for five years in Paris beginning in 1867. Ramsey painted landscapes, narrative scenes, and still lifes of fruit, flowers, and game in a style inspired by eighteenth century French still lifes, Ramsey exhibited regularly at the National Academy of Design in New York, and Atlantic City.



31: Clarkson Frederick Stanfield, Oil Painting of a Stormy Nautical Scene

One oil on canvas painting depicting a nautical scene in a storm. A dark and cloudy sky fills most of the composition. Two ships appear in the foreground, their sails violently whipping in the wind. Other ships are visible in the background. A hill is visible on the right side with a small building atop. The artwork is housed in a simple, gilded wood frame.Clarkson Frederick Stanfield (1793-1867) was an English painter known for his marine subjects. A former sailor and member of the Royal Navy, his works were often large-scale and depicted dramatic nautical scenes. His work can be found in numerous British collections, including the National Maritime Museum, London, and the art gallery of his native Sunderland.



32: Rachel Hartley, Oil Painting of American Beach Scene "Westhampton, New York"

The artwork is housed in a decorative golden frame.Rachel Hartley (1884-1955) was the granddaughter of George Inness (1825-1894), and the daughter of sculptor Jonathan Hartley. She began to paint and sketch at age 10. She studied at the Art Students League of NY, and she later became a teacher of the League, and a member of the American Federation of the Arts. Also a member of the Pen and Brush Club, and organization that supported women artists and authors, Hartly is best known for her social realist and American impressionism paintings. Born in New York, she studied at the Art Students League, and became a member of the American Federation for Arts and the Pen and Brush Club. Hartley exhibited at the well-known MacBeth Gallery in New York.

33: Caroline M. Bell "Harbor Scene" Oil Painting

One oil on canvas board depicting a large sailboat at a dock where two people stand. The artwork is housed in a simple brown wooden frame.Caroline "Dolly" Martha Bell (1874–1970) was an American artist and educator, who painted water and landscape scenes mostly around the Peconic region of Long Island, New York. Throughout Bell's career she participated in approximately 75 exhibitions across Long Island, New York City, upstate New York, and Massachusetts. In 1941 Bell won first prize at an exhibition held by the Long Island Federation of Women's Club. Today, Bell's paintings are still used in exhibitions in many Long Island museums and Galleries.



34: Roger Lersy Oil Painting of an Abstract Fish

One oil on canvas painting depicting an abstract deep sea fish in hues of beige, brown, pink, and blue. The painting is housed in a simple wooden frame.Roger Lersy (1920-2004) was a painter, lithographer and musician-composer born in Paris. Lersy lived in extreme poverty in his youth, before studying art and music at the École des Arts Apppliqués. Lersy first exhibited in Paris 1946, and received the Prix des Amateurs d'Art in 1953, the Shell Prize in 1954 and the Grand Prize of the City of Marseilles in 1953.



35: Roger Lersy Oil Painting of an Abstract Ship in a Storm

One oil on canvas painting of an abstract sail boat at sea. The boat and its sail occupy the majority of the composition. The artwork is unframed.Roger Lersy (1920-2004) was a painter, lithographer and musician-composer born in Paris. Lersy lived in extreme poverty in his youth, before studying art and music at the 'ncole des Arts Apppliqués. Lersy first exhibited in Paris 1946, and received the Prix des Amateurs d'Art in 1953, the Shell Prize in 1954 and the Grand Prize of the City of Marseilles in 1953.



36: Lenci Porcelain Double Vase Depicting the World Map

One conjoined double white vase featuring painted depictions of the world map. Additional painted motifs include a compass, dragon, several sailboats, and a figure representing the wind. Painted trees and animals are featured upon different continents, such as an elephant in Asia and a bison in North America. The Lenci Factory was established in 1919 in Turin, Italy by wife and husband Helen Konig and Enrico Scavini. Under the direction of Elena, Lenci began manufacturing ceramics in 1927. Lenci produced striking Art Deco figurines, dolls, and other accessories.



37: Royal Vienna Porcelain Figurine of a Young Girl "Figurine of Girl"

A Royal Vienna Hand Painted porcelain figurine bust of a young girl. She wears a purple and yellow dress with a blue bow at the neck. Her blue bonnet is adorned with flowers, and her hair peaks out from the bonnet. Her expression is emotionless. She has red lips and her eyes are looking to the side.



38: Royal Vienna Porcelain Plate featuring a Painted Scene with Venus "Venus Bei Ihrer"

One Royal Vienna hand-painted porcelain plate depicting Venus seated and draped in white and pink robes. She sits in an outdoor space, the background filled with trees and glimpses of a clear sky. 43: KPM Berlin Hand Painted Porcelain Plaque Scene Featuring Psyche "Psyche mit der Urne"

One hand-painted porcelain plaque depicting the Greek goddess Psyche in profile view staring into the mouth of a black and gold-accented urn in the middle of a lusciously foliaged landscape. Psyche wears a one-shouldered two-piece dress in white and blue which is embroidered with gold designs. To Psyche's right is a butterfly, a symbol of rebirth and resurrection. This scene refers to the task set to Psyche by the goddess Venus to retrieve water from the River Styx. This plaque is housed in a decorative gold-colored frame.



44: KPM Berlin Hand Painted Porcelain Plaque Featuring a Young Pompeian Woman "A Pompeian Flower" USD 3,000 - 5,000

One hand-painted porcelain plaque depicting a young woman standing against a wall in Pompeian garb. 48: KPM Berlin Hand Painted Porcelain Plaque Scene "Shakespeare in the Court of Elizabeth I"

One hand-painted porcelain plaque depicting William Shakespeare entertaining Queen Elizabeth I and her court in a draped and columned garden. Shakespeare stands before the gathering with a hand raised above his head. A peacock stands in the foreground while a small child plays with a dog at the lower left of the image, tended to by her mother. A second dog sits in front of the peacock, eyes trained on Shakespeare. The plaque is housed in a decorative gold-colored frame.







Still arguably the best-known Chicago woman artist of her time, Pauline Lennards (or Lennard) Palmer was born in McHenry, Illinois, attended school in Milwaukee, and taught art in Chicago public schools. Her marriage in 1891 to prosperous Chicago physician Albert Palmer enabled her to have a fulltime career as an artist. Palmer studied at the Art Institute of Chicago and began exhibiting there in 1896; she completed her formal training with three years of study in art academies in Paris. On her return to Chicago in 1902, Palmer opened a portrait studio and she quickly established herself as a fixture in the city's art world. She exhibited regularly in the Art Institute's three annual exhibitions and in important national and international exhibitions, notably the prestigious Paris Salon. At the Art Institute, she won numerous prizes. Her first solo exhibition was held there in 1913 at the same time as the famous so-called Armory Show of modernist art.In 1917, Palmer joined the influential artists' community in the Tree Studios building on Chicago's Near North Side. A leader among local artists, she was the first woman to serve as president of the Chicago Society of Artists, between 1918 and 1921, and she led the Association of Chicago Painters and Sculptors from 1929 to 1931. Palmer and her husband traveled widely, making several visits to Europe. In 1910 she worked in Giverny, France, an international center of impressionist practice where she absorbed the influence of American figural painter Richard Emil Miller. Beginning in 1915, the Palmers spent summers in Provincetown, Massachusetts, a popular seasonal colony for both modernist and conservative artists; after her husband's death in 1920 she spent more time there, making light-filled figural and landscape paintings.Palmer was adept in oil, pastel, tempera, and watercolor. In addition to portraits, she painted numerous studies of women and children as well as landscapes. Her work matured from a dark, tonal, academic approach to a conservative impressionism in which forms are suggested by distinct brushstrokes of brilliant color that emphasize the effects of full sunlight. Known as "Chicago's painter lady,? Palmer was a perennial local favorite for her pleasing subjects and accessible style. In 1926 Chicago Tribune art critic Eleanor Jewett described her as one of "the two most popular and best liked artists belonging to Chicago's art colony? (Frederic M. Grant was the other). At the Art Institute, notwithstanding modernism's dominance by the 1930s, Palmer was honored with a solo memorial exhibition the year after her death, as well as with one at the Union League Club of Chicago.


